## **LEGAL STUDIES**

## (FOR 1 TO 3 HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS)

Through the use of realistic scenarios and case studies, students explore family, workplace and consumer law. The focus is on the individual's basic rights, and their responsibilities at a place of work and in the community. The legal aspects of buying, selling and renting goods and services will be studied. Students may also explore the legal relationship between the government and the citizen with an emphasis on criminal law.

## GENERAL PSYCHOLOGY 20 (FOR 3 HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS)

This course deals with many different aspects of psychology, and often is seen as an overview and introduction to the world of psychology in general. For those interested in entering careers in Counseling, Social Work, Psychology, or Psych Nursing, this would serve as an introduction to basic concepts and terms used in the Science of Psychology.
